



PERMANENT MISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Croatia, in accordance with its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations in his capacity as the depositary of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea of 1982, adds hereto her nonobjection to inform of the following:

The Croatian Parliament adopted the Decision on the proclamation of the exclusive economic zone of the Republic of Croatia in their session on 10 February, 2021, which will enter into force on 10 February, 2022.

By that Decision of the Croatian Parliament, as of 10 February, 2022, the exclusive economic zone of the Republic of Croatia will be established beyond the outer limit of its territorial sea in accordance with the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea. The exclusive economic zone of the Republic of Croatia, in accordance with the outer limit of the territorial sea seawards up to the maximum limit allowed by general international law. The outer limit of the exclusive economic zone of the Republic of Croatia shall be determined by international agreements on delimitation with the States whose coasts lie opposite or adjacent to the Republic of Croatia.

Pending the conclusion of the agreements on delimitation, the outer limit of the exclusive economic zone of the Republic of Croatia shall initially follow the continental shelf delimitation, as from the 1982 Agreement between the German Democratic Republic on the Delimitation of the Continental Shelf between the two countries in the Adriatic Sea and the 2005 Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Croatia and the Government of the Italian Republic on the provisional delimitation of the continental shelves for the Republic of Croatia and the Italian Republic and adjacent areas, delimitation with Montenegro, the Republic of Croatia, continuing along the provisional delimitation line of the territorial seas, as defined in the 2002 Protocol of the Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Germany concerning the Territorial Sea of Yugoslavia on the basis of the Phini Regime along the southern border between the two states.

Without prejudice to the sovereignty, rights and jurisdiction of the Republic of Croatia, the exclusive economic zone of the Republic of Croatia remains a maritime area where all States "nauti" enjoy freedom, as guaranteed under international law for navigation, overflight, laying of submarine cables and pipelines and other marine activities.
