The Secretary General of the United Nations has received from the Secretary-General of Chile a communication dated 20 September 1974, in which the Secretary-General of Chile requests that the United Nations Secretariat should, in accordance with article 84, paragraph 1, of the Charter of the United Nations, and article 16, paragraph 1, of the Convention on the High Seas, determine the maritime baselines of Chile in accordance with the provisions of article 16, paragraph 1, of the Convention on the High Seas, concerning the straight and normal baselines of contiguous zones, and the normal baselines of the maritime zone, measured from the low water line, and the "Local Datum" concerning the maritime baselines of Chile.

With regard to the point of the maritime baselines, the following points defined in the maritime baselines of Chile, as shown in Chart No. 1 of the United Nations Secretariat of the High Seas (Second Edition) are hereby notified to the United Nations Secretariat of the High Seas:

“The Republic of Chile reserves its rights according to its preliminary submission to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, dated 8 May 2009, concerning its continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles, pursuant to Article 76 of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea”.
