The Secretary-General of the United Nations has the honor to inform you that on 14 September 2000, the Government of Chile deposited with the Secretary-General of the United Nations a map entitled "Determination of the Maritime Boundary of Chile and Argentina, dated 12 April 1994," which contains the maritime boundary between Chile and Argentina, measured from the baseline from which the 3 nautical miles limit of Chile's territorial sea is measured. This map is deposited in accordance with article 84, paragraph 2, of the Convention concerning the Territorial Sea and the Contiguous Zone, and in accordance with article 10, paragraph 1, of the Convention on the Determination of the Maritime Boundary of Chile and Argentina, dated 12 April 1994.

With regard to the deposit of the map mentioned above, the Secretary-General has the honor to inform you that "[...] Chile, Notified confidentially and the map is deposited in accordance with article 84, paragraph 2, of the Convention concerning the Territorial Sea and the Contiguous Zone, and in accordance with article 10, paragraph 1, of the Convention on the Determination of the Maritime Boundary of Chile and Argentina, dated 12 April 1994." 
