

New York, 27 September 2024 – The United Nations Of ice of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT) and the League of Arab States - Secretariat General signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) today to strengthen their partnership in countering terrorism and preventing violent extremism conducive to terrorism.

The MoU establishes a framework for cooperat on between both ent t es over the next f ve years, and will be put into pract ce through regular consultat ons, discussions and events on issues related to countering terrorism; informat on exchange, including on capacity-building init at ves to strengthen counter-terrorism responses, at global, regional and nat onal levels; ident fying, collect ng and sharing of good pract ces on issues of common interest.

The MoU was signed by

, during a bilateral meeting on the margins of the 79th session of the United Nations General Assembly High-Level Week.

The agreement with the League of Arab States is a key contribut on to UNOCT's strategy to broaden and deepen its partnerships with regional organizations. In light of the ever-evolving threats of terrorism and violent extremism, such partnerships serve to inform the Of ce's policy work and programmatic activities and integrate multi-disciplinary approaches to countering terrorism.
