United Nations International Conference on Victims of Terrorism in Spain gives a message of global solidarity and calls for greater support for victims worldwide

Vitoria-Gasteiz (Spain), 8 October 2024 - The United Nations International Conference on Victims of Terrorism, co-organized by the United Nations Office of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT) and the Kingdom of Spain, on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] October [REDACTED], started today at the Palacio de Congresos Europa in Vitoria-Gasteiz.
