It became part of the Office of Counter-Terrorism (OCT) when the Office was established in June 2017. Since its establishment, UNCCT has delivered a broad range of capacity-building support to Member States in support of their implementation of the UN Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy. Since 2016, UNCCT has been guided by its 5-Year Programme that sets out four outcomes aligned with the Strategy, and 12 related outputs that ensure prioritized capacity-building in a balanced manner.
