Excellencies,

Further to my letter dated 21 August 2020, and in accordance with the decision of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea adopted at the plenary meeting of the thirtieth Meeting of States Parties to the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea, held on 21 August 2020, I have the honour to inform you that the election of seven members of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea has been completed. The elected members are: (a) 1.999 (b) 4.003 (c) 0.612 (d) 1.760 (e) 2.999 (f) 3.996 (g) 4.003.

The second round of balloting (first restricted ballot) will be restricted to the two candidates from the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States who were not elected but obtained the greatest number of votes in the previous ballot, namely Ms. Kathy-Ann Brown (Jamaica) and Mr. Rodrigo Fernandes More (Brazil).

Information on the conduct of the election is enclosed in **Annex B**.

I thank the tellers and the staff of the United Nations Secretariat for their assistance in the first round of the election held today.
