



Jacques van Zuydam is the Head (Chief Director) of the National Population Unit of the government of South Africa. His work entails integrating population concerns into the programmes of national government departments, provinces and local governments in South Africa, along with forging relationships with the international community and NGOs to support population and development in South Africa. His responsibilities also include population and development research and to monitor and evaluate the implementation of the country's population policy. He regularly represents South Africa on international population affairs in the United Nations, African Union, the Partners in Population and Development (PPD), BRICS and the Southern African Development Community (SADC). Jacques has a Master of Arts (MA) degree in Sociology and is a Fellow of the international Leadership for Environment and Development (LEAD) Programme.
