It is for instance now incumbent upon Government to ensure the right to education, the right to economic participation and of special relevance to today's gathering, the right to health. Under section 31 of the Constitution, the State is required to take reasonable measures to achieve the conditions and

services, including reproductive health care. To complement the Fijian government's work towards the progressive realization of all human rights, concerted action by the international community through support of such national efforts is required.
