measures to reach the target of enrolling every single Syrian child. The 2017-2018 Regional Refugee Resilience Plan also recognizes the important role of youth and adolescents in supporting families and contributing to their communities.

In order to address social and health service needs of women and girls, together with the UNFPA, we have established 41 women and girls' safe spaces (WGSS) in urban areas across Turkey. In 2018, this cooperation will expand by 35 social service centers that can reach over 1 million people, through providing psychosocial support, basic sexual and reproductive health services, legal advice and Turkish language lessons. Since 2015, hundreds of thousands Syrians received services through the safe spaces in Turkey.
