As we reflect on actions needed to further implement the ICPD Programme of Action, we are in a particularly challenging time unprovoked and unjustifiable invasion of Ukraine is threatening international peace and security, causing widespread humanitarian consequences, and resulting in the senseless deaths of thousands of civilians. The COVID-19 pandemic has amplified pre-existing inequalities within and across countries, particularly for women and girls in all their diversity, marginalized groups and individuals in situations of vulnerability. Conflict, climate change, food insecurity and malnutrition, biodiversity loss, and ecosystem degradation are major challenges threatening our shared future, but particularly impacting Indigenous peoples and those who have least contributed to the climate emergency. We have the opportunity now to leverage pandemic response and recovery and climate action to build a more equitable, gender-responsive, and sustainable future for all.

Canada reaffirms that health, including sexual and reproductive health and rights, is a precondition for sustainable and inclusive economic growth. These are just some of the reasons why accelerating the implementation of the ICPD Programme of Action, and building on the Nairobi ICPD@25 Summit commitments, is so relevant today.
