



Sweden, together with Brazil, Philippines, Zambia, UNESCO, UNICEF, and Global Partnership for Education, will host a dynamic event featuring speakers from across the world, including education and health policy makers, development partners and young people, to highlight the positive and transformative impact of education and school health and nutrition on health and well-being. This transformation yields a triple dividend by impacting the lives of children and adolescents today, their adulthood, and the generation of children to come. For example, school feeding programmes deliver US\$9 in returns for every US\$1 invested, and school programmes that address mental health can potentially provide a return on investment of US\$21.5 for every US\$1 invested. The event will show-case the linkages between education, health and well-being, and how countries can best invest in the health, growth and development of learners through an integrated approach to school health and nutrition.
