DEVELOPMENT FORM THE BASIS OF OUR GLOBAL COMMITMENT, IN LINE WITH THE 2030 AGENDA FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND THE 2063 AGENDA OF THE AFRICAN UNION, WHICH ESTABLISH A COMMON VISION FOR A MORE PROSPEROUS AND SUSTAINABLE WORLD, FOR THE BENEFIT OF CURRENT AND FUTURE GENERATIONS.

- 3. THE REPUBLIC OF ANGOLA HAS MADE SIGNIFICANT PROGRESS IN RECENT YEARS IN THE SOCIAL FIELD, NAMELY IN EDUCATION, WOMEN'S HEALTH, SCHOOLING FOR YOUNG PEOPLE, THE FIGHT AGAINST DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, GENDER BALANCE, AND THE FIGHT AGAINST CORRUPTION, DEMONSTRATING OUR DETERMINATION TO ADDRESS THE CRUCIAL ISSUES OF POPULATION, DEVELOPMENT AND SOCIAL PROGRESS.
- 4. IN THIS REGARD, LET ME POINT OUT THAT IN THE NOTABLE PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE, WITH AN INCREASE IN THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ENROLLMENT RATE TO 76% BY 2022.
