recent years to continue. The resources mobilized are far lower than required given the growing needs and costs. This is true for all four components of the costed package, particularly for family planning and reproductive health.

Indeed, if funding for family planning and reproductive health is not increased, it will undermine efforts to nevent unintended pregnancies and reduce meternal and shild mortality important than ever.

	In closing, I would like to repeat: the ICPD goals are essential for meeting the Millennium Development Goals. But we must have adequate resources to do so. This will only
	come about when donor countries, international agencies and developing countries strengthen
