

**Statement of the Mission of Bangladesh to the United Nations  
after the adoption of the resolution on the**

**“Assessment of the Status of Implementation of the Programme of Action of the  
International Conference on Population and Development”**

**47th session of the Commission on Population and Development of the United Nations  
Economic and Social Council**

**New York, 12 April 2014**

Thank you, Mr. Chair, for giving me the floor. Mr. Chair, I am taking the floor to explain Bangladesh's position on the resolution that has just been adopted. We congratulate Mr. Chair, and through you and to the bureau and the Member States for adoption of the resolution a while ago. We appreciate the work that is being carried out by the Chair and the co-facilitators and the bureau members. While we understand the process for having a 47<sup>th</sup> CPD outcome was turbulent from the very beginning, this session, and particularly, the resolution could have been benefited profusely on the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the ICPD if the procedural matters and utilization of the negotiation time and process could better be handled.
