







On 11 December 1997, the Government of the Saharan Arab Democratic Republic (SADR) signed the peace agreement in Paris.

In this context, the Royal Consultative Council for the Sahara Affairs (CORCAS), representative body composed by 111 members, their substitutes, as well as the various political and social and socio-economic interfaces of the region, pledged its full commitment to the process of elaborating this autonomy statute.
