Mr. President,

Zambia has registered positive economic growth averaging 5.6 percent per annum over the past ten years. Progress is being made in reducing HIV prevalence, maternal and infant mortality, increasing women and youth empowerment and primary school enrolment. However, challenges still remain in providing universal access to sexual

and reproductive health information and services, high teenage pregnancies, reduction of poverty and economic inequality, among others.

As part of remedial measures to the observed challenges, Zambia has put in place various policies and programmes to advance the economic and social status of women and

young people especially girls, through the Citizen Economic Empowerment fund and Youth Development fund.

The Government policies and strategies which include the National Population Policy, National Health Policy, National Gender Policy, National Youth Policy, Reproductive Health and the Re-Entry Policy for girls who become pregnant, have enhanced the women and girls social economic status, though much more remains to be done. The Government has further developed the National Strategy for Development of Statistics (NSDS) in order to lay

a foundation for evidence based decision making in the implementation of the strategies mentioned above. The

strategy is also intended to holistically harmonize data collection and monitoring and evaluation systems in the country.
