2. Content

- 2.1 Elements for the Global Compact would include the following:
 - International migration as a multidimensional reality of major relevance for the development of countries of origin, transit and destination (as recognized in the 2030 Agenda).
 - Effective protection of the human rights and fundamental freedoms of all migrants, especially women at risk and children, regardless of their migratory status. The specific human rights protection needs of migrants in vulnerable situations.
 - The contribution made by migrants to sustainable development when their rights are
 <u>protected, respected and fulfilled,</u> and the complex interrelationship between migration
 and development.
 - The impact of migration on human capital in countries of origin.
 - Remittances as an important contribution to development and a source of private capital.
 - A holistic view of migration in all its dimensions.
 - Effective protection of the human rights and fundamental freedoms of all migrants, especially women and children, regardless of their migratory status. The specific needs of migrants in vulnerable situations.
 - Border managementgovernance.
 - Combatting human trafficking and addressing migrant smuggling.
 - Promotion of the inclusion migrants in host societies.
