Crude Birth Rate: Number of live births in year per thousand population. Crude Death Rate: Number of deaths in year per thousand population.


Infant Mortality Rate: Infant (under one year) deaths per thousand live births.

of mortality at the time of birth were to stay the same throughout his/her life.
