In 2000, we all, as UN Member States undertook to reduce by half the proportion of people living on less than a dollar a day by 2015. While some progress has been made, there are still over one billion people living in extreme poverty and over 550 million undernounshed and or food-insecure. A disproportionate number of these are women and children. Moreover, there is a significant degree of variation in progress towards the eradication of poverty and hunger across regions, between countries, and among communities.
