


Following an overall review of travel entitlements by OHRM, this report presents twenty recommendations that are designed to better utilize resources for air travel.


The Secretary-General recommends an inclusion in the administrative instruction on official travel a provision that would inform all officials of the United Nations not to use, for personal travel, any frequent flyer miles gained as a result of conducting official business on behalf of the Organization. Further, all officials of the United Nations would be encouraged to use for official travel any frequent flyer miles gained as a result of
