Mr. Chairman,

l also have the honour to introduce the Secretærne@al's report of the budget performance for the period 2013/14, and the budget proposals for thie \$\phi 2015/16\$ for UNMIK and MINURSO also listed in today's journal as Agenda items 158 and 1.1

The proposed 2015/16 budget to hill amounts to \$41.4 million representing a decretase percent compared to the 2014/15 budget, primatify to lower civilian personnel costs, partly offset by increases in information technolog

The proposed 2015/16 budget MINURSO amounts to \$53.3 million representing a decrease o 1.2 percent compared to the 2014/15 budget, primattiributable to a decrease in the number of posts.

Mr. Chairman,

While not part of the agenda items being introdutes morning, I wish to also take this opportunity to draw the attention of this Committee he note of the Secretary-General in connection with the financing arrangements MbNUSMA for 1 July 2014 to 30 June 2015 which will be coming forward for your consideration. Thete lays out a proposal for increased requirements for MINUSMA for the current period enating from the request of the Security Council to take the necessary steps to enable its on to reach its full operational capacity as soon as possible within the context of a new Ftargetown, which is critical for the Mission's operations in northern Mali where a complex seguent vironment with asymmetric threats exists. No provision was made at the time of formulating thudget for 2014/15. I wish to appeal to the Committee to accelerate consideration of this returned available.
