## 70/409. Appointment of a member of the Board of Auditors

## 70/410. Election of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees

At its 57th plenary meeting, on 18 November 2015, the General Assembly, on the proposal of the Secretary-General,<sup>8</sup> elected Mr. Filippo GRANDI as United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees for a period of five years beginning on 1 January 2016 and ending on 31 December 2020.

## 70/411. Board of the 10-Year Framework of Programmes on Sustainable Consumption and Production Patterns

At its 58th plenary meeting, on 19 November 2015, the General Assembly, on the proposal of its President,<sup>9</sup> decided that, as nominated by the five regional groups of the United Nations, ALBANIA, ARGENTINA, GERMANY, INDONESIA, KENYA, MEXICO, NIGERIA, the REPUBLIC OF KOREA, ROMANIA
