"he Committee proposes reductions in the resources proposed \$or o\$\$icial travel, the ac/uisition o\$ ne - vehicles, and the Mission's unmanned aircra\$t systems +UAS,!

0 ith respect to the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo +UNMIK,, the Advisory Committee recommends approval o\$ the sta\$\$in# chan#es in the proposed *ud#et - hich comprise a net reduction o\$ &' civilian posts or positions includin# 1' national posts! "he Committee, ho - ever, recalls that the 5 eneral Assem*ly had noted the need \$or missions to *uild national capacity and reiterates its support to the trend to - ards nationalisation o\$ posts and positions, - henever possi*le!

"he Advisory Committee \$urther notes that the proposed sta\$\$in# reductions include a num*er o\$ su*stantive posts3positions and hi#hli#hts that the Secretary65 eneral re\$lects these reductions as @e\$\$iciency #ainsA! It e9pects that the Secretary65 eneral - ill provide \$urther e9planations on this matter to the 5 eneral Assem*ly!

"he Advisory Committee commends UNMIK \$or its e\$\$orts to introduce rene - a*le ener#y alternatives and \$or its comprehensive approach to - aste mana#ement!

Overall, the Advisory Committee recommends approval o\\$ the proposed *ud#et \\$ or the \& '1<\31(period!

"he Committee also /uestions the proposed resource increases \$or & '1<31(under *oth civilian personnel +%<!2 million or 11!< per cent, and \$or outsourced services +%2!(million or &)!; per cent,! "he Committee is o\$ the vie - that the Secretary65 eneral should have provided clarity - ith respect to these proposed resource increases, in particular concernin# the respective \$unctions and locations o\$ sta\$\$ and consultants!
