Mr. Chairman, Distinguished Delegates,

Now, I would like to introduce statement of programme budget implications relating to draft resolution A/C.3/74/L.29 Situation of human rights of Rohingya Muslims and other (A/C.5/74/11). In order to implement the requests contained in the draft resolution, the Secretary-General proposes resources in the amount of \$1,073,000, net of staff assessment, for continuing the provision of the good offices of the Secretary-General, including the requirements for the salaries and related staffing costs of the Special Envoy and four other positions, as well as other operational requirements. Approval for these requirements and appropriation is being sought in the context of the proposed programme budget for 2020 under section 3, Political affairs, for special political missions (A/74/6 (Sect.3)/Add.2), which provides further details, and which is currently before the Assembly.
