

STATEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE GROUP OF 77 AND CHINA BY H.E. AMBASSADOR FEDA ABDELHADY, DEPUTY PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE, MISSION OF THE STATE OF PALESTINE TO THE UNITED NATIONS, ON THE ORGANIZATION OF WORK FOR THE MAIN PART OF THE SEVENTY-FOURTH SESSION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

- 7. In the coming weeks, the Fifth Committee will address issues of crucial importance. The Group sees as pivotal elements of our deliberations this session both the 2020 programme plan and the proposed programme budget for that same year. The Group stresses in this regard that the level of resources to be approved by the General Assembly must be commensurate with all mandated programmes and activities in order to ensure their full and effective implementation. The Group also reiterates its long standing position that mandates must determine budget proposals and not the other way around.
