



STATEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE GROUP OF 77 AND CHINA BY MS. MEGAYLA AUSTIN, MINISTER COUNSELLOR OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF T FOR 2021: REVISED SIONS ADOPTED BY SION, AT THE MAIN -FIFTH SESSION OF
