Mr. Chairman,
Distinguished Delegates,

1. I have the honour to introduce the report of the Secretary-General on the request for a subvention to the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (ECCC) (A/75/242). The report outlines the substantive progress and results achieved by the ECCC under each of the judicial cases. It underlines the continuing financial challenges faced by the ECCC in 2020 and presents the 2021 requirements for both national and international components of the ECCC.

2. Despite the ongoing fundraising efforts undertaken by the United Nations Secretariat, the negative trend of voluntary contributions continued in 2020 and was further exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic. The ECCC has therefore continued implementing measures to address the funding shortfall, while maintaining its most critical functions in the effort to avoid any impact to the judicial proceedings. These measures include freezing recruitment against vacant posts, where possible. In combination with the subvention from the regular budget of \$7 million for 2020, these measures have resulted in

ensuring that the funds cover the minimum operations of the international component of the ECCC through the end of 2020; however, these have also affected the staff morale, as this impacted the duration of personnel contracts. With insufficient funds available at the beginning of the year, contract extensions had to be implemented in four steps during 2020.
