



Nonetheless, given the challenges faced, we continue to encourage the Secretariat to prioritise and use its resources effectively, and where necessary agilely, including in response to new mandates, and emerging priorities and challenges, in support of delivery.

Mr Chair,

The Secretary General has warned us of the significant amount of credits due to be returned to member states in 2023, and the potentially devastating impact this could have on the United Nations liquidity. We have another opportunity this session to agree measures to mitigate the impact of this extraordinary situation and to help the Organisation better manage liquidity over the longer-term.

The United Kingdom stands ready to work with our fellow member states to live up to our responsibilities and agree solutions that put the United Nations on a better financial footing.
