We have the honour to address you in our capacity as **Co-Chairs of the Intergovernmental Negotiations** on the question of equitable representation on and increase in the membership of the Security Council and other related matters to the Security Council (IGN) during the 78th session of the General Assembly.

We thank all delegations for their constructive spirit and engagement throughout the negotiations on the input of the IGN to be submitted to the Co-Facilitators of the Summit of the Future for inclusion in Chapter V of the Pact for the Future. Throughout this process, delegations have engaged in good faith and in a spirit of cooperation and mutual trust. We are truly grateful for all the support!

We listened carefully to the different views expressed during the last IGN meeting on Thursday, 20 June 2024. Based on this feedback and after careful considerations and consultations with Member States and Groups of States, we have the honour to circulate the revised version of the language on Security Council Reform to be included in the **Pact for the Future**. - (c) Actively reinforce the ongoing efforts of the Security Council to review and enhance its working methods, including inter alia, penholding and co-penholding arrangements, and strengthen the cooperation and communication between the Security Council and the General Assembly and its subsidiary bodies, including the Peacebuilding Commission, as well as the Economic and Social Council and regional and sub-regional arrangements, including by continuing to fully implement and make use of General Assembly Resolutions 377A(V)
- (d) Improve the participation in and access to the work of the Security Council and its subsidiary organs for all members of the General Assembly, to enhance the Council's accountability to the membership and increase the transparency of its work.
