

Towards a Sustainable Future for All Women and Girls:

Background:

Based on latest available data for 2013, an estimated 767 million people lived below the international poverty line of \$1.90 a day down from 1.7 billion people in 1999. The figure reflects a decrease in the global poverty rate from 28 per cent in 1999 to 11-2(a)4(b)-10(l)-2(e)4(da)
