## STATEMENT

by Representative of the Russian Federation
in the Sixth Committee of the 68 Session of the General Assembly
on Agenda Item: Report of the UN Special Committee
on the Charter of the United Nations
and on the Strengthening of the Role of the Organization

Mr. Chair,

The Russian Federation suppose the work of the Special Committee on the Charter of the United Nations and onethStrengthening of the Role of the Organization. We believe that it is abble address complex legal issues associated with the work of the Organization on the basis of genately recognized principles and norms of the International Law. Thus Committee is marking its contribution to the Rule of Law at the internation believel that has been recently discussed in such a detail over the last few days.

Criticisms have been voiced onceaing at the spring session of the Special Committee regarding the slowing down to pace of work of this body. We partially share these concernisced, at the current teste the special Committee is living through a not so much ctive stage in its history. herefore, we do not deny

the need for a certain balæed optimization of its who. However we cannot agree with the proposals to totally switch the nonittee to a "sleeping" mode. It goes without saying that the Sepial Committee should contine its work on a regular basis and maintain its ability to take tops examination anyusbstantial proposals within its competencewhen necessary.

Let us recall in this connection that Special Committee has had for quite a while a joint Russia-Belarus proposalitiss backlog on requesting an advisory opinion of the International Court of Jussiion the legal effects of the use of force by the states without ipour authorization by the Security Council. Unfortunately we have not been able so faor unwind this issue on accessnsus basis. We believe however that this poposal has a potential.

In conclusion, we would like to note ath the important work conducted by the UN Secretariat to prepare the Repreptof the Practice of the United Nations Organs and the Repertoins the Practice of the Security Council. It is our understanding that the Secretariat, enwholdrafting the handbook on the practice of the Security Council, will fully comply with relevant regulations on tained in the report of the Secretary Genal, dated 18 September 1952.
