- Second, despite such support, there remain sôtates who oppose the
 conclusion of a convention, including for reasons regarding concerns
 relating to specific provisions of thæticles on diplomatic protection; and
- Third, there exist a further group States who would perfer to defer a decision on how to proceed, one waythour other, until the final decision on the fate of the articles on the respiconisty of States for internationally wrongful acts is taken.

With these conclusion is mind, there was agreement in the Working Group that the most feasible way forward, the present sess, own as to work on the basis of a draft resolution deferring decision on the fate of the articles on diplomatic protection to a future session.
