We also appreciate the support of UN missions on standards and procedures for alerting UN Headquarters on instances of criminal misconduct by civilian and military or police personnel in such cases to judicial authorities of host countries and, where relevant, the contributing country, for purposes of criminal responsibility and prosecution.

In this regard, my delegation stands ready to cooperate in order to conclude the pending discussion since 2017 on a proposed international UN personnel liability convention with a view to strengthening the protection of UN personnel.
