Mr. Chair

As this is the first time I take the floor, I would like to congratulate you and the members of the bureau on your election. My delegation assures you of our full cooperation and support for the work of the Committee.

Terrorism continues to be a global threat, and the relevance of our work on this topic, who instigate and nurture extremism, the drivers of such come from a variety of factors, and address these issues firmly and firmly.

It is therefore significant that the General Assembly, by consensus, adopted the 10th review of the Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy, which brought about substantial developments in response to the ever-changing global terrorism threat. We face increased risks on women and young people, and we will continue to address these important updates in this regard.

This review particularly focused on the prevention of terrorism, conducive to terrorism. Resolution A/70/291 includes recommendations from the Secretary-General's Plan of Action to Prevent Violent Extremism, which that now needs national, regional and global implementation. My delegation like to use this opportunity to thank the Secretary-General for his leadership on this issue and encourage his successor to carry on the vision of the Secretary-General throughout the UN system.
