With respect to "Provisional application of treaties", the Commission adopted at this year's session the draft guidelines 1 to 11 and the commentaries thereto. The Chinese delegation commends the Commission for its progress on this topic. We have noted that draft guideline 6 establishes a "default rule", namely the provisional application of a treaty produces the same legal effect as if the treaty were in force, unless the parties indicate to the contrary.
