Indonesia continues to hold the view that universal jurisdiction is not the primary jurisdiction for combating impunity and shall only be exercised in exceptional cases. In that regard, it is

complementary to territoriality and nationality jurisdiction, but not a substitute for it. It serves to close the legal gaps when no states are able or willing to exercise the jurisdiction.

Fighting impunity is urgent and imperative, but we need to be fully aware that this undertaking

must also respect the principle of sovereign equality, territorial integrity, due process, principle of good faith and the principle of immunity of the Head of State and high ranking officials, as
