Georgia is a strong supporter of the promotion of and respect for international law and rules-based international order and remains committed to the principles enshrined in the United Nations Charter.

Georgia recognizes the compulsory jurisdiction of the International Court of Justice in accordance with Article 36 of the Statute of the Court and reaffirms its support to primacy of peaceful settlement of disputes.

Two decades after the adoption of the Rome Statute, we remain committed to strengthening the International Criminal Court as a legal institution, inter alia, by contributing to enforcement of

In January 2019, the Government of Georgia and the ICC concluded an Agreement on the Enforcement of Sentences. Under the agreement, persons convicted by the ICC may serve their sentence of
