‘Responsibility of States for internationally wrongful acts’

Mr. Chairperson,

The normative framework around the responsibility of the State is the backbone of international law. This set of norms arises from the principles delineated in the Charter of the United Nations.



Mr. Chairperson,

My delegation reiterates its long-standing position that codifying the articles in a binding instrument, such as a convention, could provide legal certainty in international relations. The time has already ripened to convene a diplomatic conference aimed at negotiating and adopting such an instrument. We also believe a dispute settlement mechanism should be included in the future convention to not only bring certainty and predictability to the application of the convention, but also prevent its
