Distinguished colleagues,

Canada welcomes the opportunity to express its views on Cluster 3 of the Draft Articles.

My delegation has emphasized, in our statement on cluster 1, the contribution that elaborating these Draft Articles into a Convention could have in the global fight against impunity for crimes against humanity. We have further noted that the definition of crimes against humanity will form the heart of any future Convention.
