Statement by the Director of the Codification Division on the Repertory of Practice of United Nations Organs

Madam/Mr Chair, Distinguished Delegates,

In the interest of time, I will deliver an abbreviated tement, considering that the outlined development selating to the Repertory of Practice of United ations Organs are accessible further details in part lof the Secretar General's report under consideration (A/78/296 of 8 August 2023). A copy of this statements available on the website of the 18th Committee.

I would like todraw your attention to the followinth ree developments:

First, with regard to the new studies in preparation:

- Bearing in mind the call made upon the Secretary-Getteral address, effectively and on a priority basis, the backlog in the preparation of volume III of the Repertottye Codification Division of the Office of Legal Affairs, acting as coordinator for the preparation of the ublication, maintained regular contact with the Faculty of Law at the University of Ottawa and Korea Universityup to 31 December 2022, when the cooperationend;
- During the period under reviewew studies were prepared as follows:

The Faculty of Law at the University of Ottawahas completed the research and drafting of studies pertaining to Supplemental Supplementa

Three consultants, financed from the trust fund for the elimination of the backlog in the Repertorny2022/23 have completed the research and drafting of four studies: on Article 19 and one on Article 103 for volume foir Supplemen No. 11, as well as one on Article 13 (a) (second part of the sentence) and one on Article 13 (a) (second part of the sentence) and one on Article 103 Supplemen No. 12. These studies have there en submitted to their author department, the Office of Legal Affairs, and an advance copy thereof has been posted of the three departments of being reviewed three departments (studyon Article 13 (1) (a)).

Lastly, onestudy on Articles 104 and 105 foupplement 11 remainsunder review by its author department, the Office of Legal Affairs. oe

- I alsothankKoreaUniversity's for the steps taken in the past yearswith a view to making a contribution to the preparation of studies;
- As mentioned in the Secreta@eneral's report, no volumes were published by the Department for General Assembly and Conference Managemeduring the period under review.
- Finally, I wish to take this opportunity to inform you that:
 - (i) Further to the Generalssembly'sappealfor States to consider sponsoring Associate Experts to work on the Repertory, relayed to all delegations by Naote Verbalæ of 9 Decembe 2022, one delegation from the Africance gion has requested information on the program;
 - (ii) I would also call upon delegations to contribute to the Trust Fund for the Repertoriyn relation to which no contribution was received during the period under review. The available balance of the furness at 30 June 2023 further to the disbursement of funfoss the three consultants recruited in 2022, is thus \$78,364 This amount is exclusive of the subsequent generous contribution of

- \$5,000 made by the Philippines, which is welcome with appreciation.
- (iii) I would finally renew my appeal to delegations to raise the interest of academic institutions in their countries or regions to participate in the preparation of studies for the Repertory. As I have previouslynderlined, geographical diversity is very important in this context.
