The draft resolution is±generally ±based on resolution87/111 adopted last yearlt includes necessary technical updates in line with the decisions made in previous resolutions, especially paragraph 2 of the annex to resolution 71/146 regarding the mandate of the Special Committeeand paragraph 5(b) of resolution 77/109 regarding subtopics of the thematic debate in future sessions. It also incorporates the recommendations made by the Chair of the Special Committee on the Repertory of Practice of United Nations Orgaansd the Repertoire of the Practice of the Security Council

The draft resolutionalso includes new language two preambulatory paragraphs, one of which relates to compliance with decisions of the International Court of Justice to which a state is a party, and one which takes note with regret that the Special Committee has not been able to agree on its report in all chapters, and encourages the Special Committee regretment of agree on all chapters of its report at its next session

In my view, the text reflects a consensus among delegations. For this reason, I recommend that the Sixth Committee adopt the draft resolution without a vote.
