## 7. Kenya

- 10. At the regional level, Kenya continues to forge strong law enforcement and judicial cooperation partnerships within the East African Community, the Intergovernmental Authority on Development (IGAD), the Great Lakes Region and continentally. However, counter-terrorism initiatives in Africa must not be seen in isolation. The interconnected nature of WRGD\¶VVHFXULW\FKDOOHQJHVGHPDQGV remain integrated into broader global strategies, avoiding isolationist approaches.
- 11. In this regard, Kenya is providing support to and calls for the strengthening of the Regional Programme Office of Counter terrorism in Nairobi, as a critical mechanism for countering violent extremism conducive to terrorism in East Africa.

Earlier this year, in February, Kenya hosted the Global Counterterrorism Forum that brought together Member States, regional organisations, lead think-tanks, civil society, and other relevant stakeholders to explore potential areas for collaborative action in countering terrorism and violent extremism.
