Mr. Chair,

At the outset, my delegation aligns itself with the statementade by the Non-Aligned Movement the GOF of the Rule of Law and the rab group and I would like to make the following remarks in our national capacity.

Jordan reaffirms that the rule of law is a fundamental pillar of the international systems phasizing critical intersection with a range of key issues such speaceand security, technology, human rights, socio economic development, and access to justice, acrossital tions including conflict and postonflict settings

Jordanrecognizes the role that the rule of law plays in building and maintaining international peace and security of accelerates action on the Sustainable Developme coals, in particular Goal 16 on peace, justice and strong institutions.

Jordan believes that the international community needs to cooperate in resolving the challenges linked to climate change, the rights of future generations, accountability forerious international community needs to cooperate and insufficiently governed digital spaces, and the use of digital technology, as the port of the Secretary General ghlights

- x In this context, we calbn the international community tensue accountability for the unlawful use of force as wellas the commission of grave international crimes, including genocide, ethnic cleansing, war crimes, andrimes against humanity against Palestinian people in Gaza, West Bank and people of Lebanon.
- x Jordan reiterates its condemnation of the ongoing violations by Israel, the occupying power, of the rule of law and their breach of international law, particularly international humanitarian law, international human rights law, and the UN Charter.
- x In the context of participation in the international legal system, Jordanreemphasizes of othe vital role womenmust playin decision making across all levels. Ensuring inclusivity is crucial for providing equal opportunities for all to influence decisionaking and the creationand implementation of the rules of international aw.
- x Jordan is of the view that sourcesof international law should

should contribute to the development of the rusteof international law.

x In closing, Jordan wishes to reiterate its commitment the advancement of the rule of law at all levels. We look forward to proactive and fruitfuldiscussions
