Statement by the representative of the Government of the Republic of Serbia
on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Serbia

1. The Government of the Republic of Serbia is pleased to participate in the 73rd session of the Third Committee of the General Assembly of the United Nations. It is pleased to see that the Committee has decided to continue its work on the agenda item "Disarmament and international security".

2. The Government of the Republic of Serbia is committed to the goal of a world free of nuclear weapons. It supports the efforts of the International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons (ICAN) and the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW). It believes that the TPNW is a landmark achievement in the disarmament process and that it will lead to the total elimination of nuclear weapons.

3. The Government of the Republic of Serbia is also committed to the goal of a world free of chemical weapons. It supports the efforts of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW) and the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC). It believes that the CWC is a landmark achievement in the disarmament process and that it will lead to the total elimination of chemical weapons.

4. The Government of the Republic of Serbia is also committed to the goal of a world free of biological weapons. It supports the efforts of the Biological Weapons Convention (BWC) and the International Convention on the Prohibition of Biological Weapons (ICPBW). It believes that the ICPBW is a landmark achievement in the disarmament process and that it will lead to the total elimination of biological weapons.
