16 July 2020 – More than 150 religious actors and prominent leaders today welcomed the momentous step taken by the representatives of the hristian! - -he global faith communities welcomed the landmark #tatement in which the leaders of all ma.or faiths in &ra' collectively denounced the acts of &#&+ and underlined their full support to victims! survivors and families! while reiterating their commitment to provide all possible support to ensure that those responsible for their crimes are held accountable, -he webinar also discussed the role of religious leaders and actors from &ra' and the other countries in promoting wider national and international accountability efforts for the crimes committed by &#&+ and other groups in &ra' and contributing to prevention of atrocity crimes and peaceful! inclusive and .ust societies,
- -he event brought together signatories to the #tatement as well as religious leaders from a wide range of other Member #tates! in order to reflect on how the principles included in the document can be converted into action and the moral force of religious actors globally can be harnessed in combatting violent e; tremism and atrocity crimes, 1 articipants underlined their united re.ection of the violence of &#&+ and emphasi%ed the importance of all religious communities in &ra'! and globally! to strengthen their dialogue and cooperation in order to promote understanding! address the legacy of &#&+ crimes and prevent atrocity crimes, 5 II participants also underlined the need for those responsible for &#&+ crimes to be held accountable in accordance with the rule of law in order to establish a basis for reconciliation and peace,
