**Facts** 

1. On 2 March 2010, the applicant filed an incomplete application with the

United Nations Dispute Tribunal regarding the recovery of an overpayment. The

applicant requested a two-month extension of time to submit a complete

application, noting that he was pursuing a resolution of the matter with the

Administration by informal means.

2. On 4 March 2010, the Tribunal granted the applicant a two-month

extension to submit a full application, i.e. until 10 May 2010.

3. On 5 May 2010, the applicant requested a further extension of time to

complete his application on the grounds that the Administration had indicated that

it was willing to reconsider the contested decision and that an informal resolution

of the dispute was still possible.

4. On 7 May 2010, the Tribunal granted the applicant a further two-month

extension, i.e. until 7 July 2010.

5. On 2 July 2010, the applicant wrote to the Tribunal to withdraw his

application, further to the parties finding an informal resolution of their dispute.

Conclusion

6. In view of the informal resolution of the dispute, the application is

withdrawn and the case is closed.
