8. The Applicant did not submit any comments to the investigation report.

9. On 7 July 2020, the ASG/OHR informed the Applicant that after review of the investigation report and the supporting documentation, it was established by a preponderance of evidence that he had falsified documents in order to claim the reimbursement of medical fees. Accordingly, the Under Secretary General for Management Strategy, Policy and Compliance decided to withdraw the Applicant's ASHI entitlements with immediate effect.





Conclusion

25. In light of the foregoing, the application is rejected as not receivable.
