1. The Appellant filed on 3 August 2020, the Appellant, a staff member of the National Operations Office on Drugs and Crime (“NODC”), contests the decision to impose on the respondent the sanction of loss of five steps, and deferment for two years of eligibility for consideration for promotion, as well as the administrative measure of requiring him to take training to improve his gender awareness and managerial sensitivity towards and harassment issues.

2. On 2 September 2020, the Respondent filed his reply.

3. On 10 October 2021, the present case was assigned to the undersigned Judge.

4. On 6 January 2022, the Tribunal issued Order No. 1 (A/2022) not finding the parties of a tentative schedule for a hearing on the merits.

5. On 13 January 2022, the Appellant filed a motion requesting the Tribunal to

10. According, therefore, the court finds it appropriate to grant the Applicant's motion.

11. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

- a. Grant the Applicant's motion to adduce evidence of arms granted; and
- b. Grant the request documents stated in para. 5 above shall be part of the record of this case and may be included in the bundle of hearing documents at the commencement of the oral hearing on the merits scheduled to start on 24 January 2022.
