1. The Applicant, a former Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Officer at the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (“UNODC”), contests the decision of 30 November 2022 to separate him from service, without compensation, in lieu of notice and without separate indemnity.

Due to the Applicant's unavailability to attend a judicial proceeding on the ground of serious health issues, the Applicant is requesting a further suspension of the proceedings "until further notice". In support, the Applicant provided a copy of the updated medical report filed on an *ex-parte* basis, which indeed recommends the postponement of the case for at least one year.

15. In view of the merits of the request, the court would be suspending the proceedings for a maximum period of no less than a year, the tribunal reserves its decision on the matter until the opposing party has submitted their response.
